

# People in power at Centre don't like criticism: Gehlot

JAIPUR, JUNE 6 /--/ Rajasthan Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot on Tuesday targeted the BJP and its leaders, saying those in power at the Centre do not like criticism.

Gehlot also said Congress leaders and workers are being portrayed in such a way as if they are not Hindus. The Chief Minister was addressing the foundation stone-laying ceremony of Agricultural Products Trade Building of Rajasthan Food Trade Association here. "A magnificent corridor of Rs 100 crore will be built in the Govind Devji temple. There is no short-

age. But we, the Congress people, are being portrayed in such a way as if we are not Hindus at all. This is unfair," he said. The corridor project is being built at the Govind Devji temple here.

The senior Congress leader said: "We have no enmity with the BJP and RSS. The fight is about ideology in a democracy. Everyone has to be taken along and everyone has to be listened to. Criticism has to be tolerated. Unfortunately, the people who are in power in Delhi today do not like to listen to criticism, whereas this is the jewel of democracy." Referring to the BJP's



"agenda of making Congress-free India", Gehlot said: "What would be the ruling party without the Opposition? There will be a ruling party when there is Opposition. You people will have to understand the atmosphere prevailing in the country." Gehlot said it is very

easy to set fire, but it takes time to douse the flames. "It takes six months to two years to build a building. If you want to demolish it, send bulldozers. This is the difference between our and their thinking. We are taking everyone along," the senior Congress leader said. He said the BJP talks about 'Sabka Sath, Sabka Vishwas', but there is a difference between their words and deeds. "The Congress wants to run on 'Sabka Sath, Sabka Vikas' concept and its policies and programmes are the same as those given by Mahatma Gandhi".

Calling upon Rajasthan to become the country's 'number one' state by 2030, Gehlot said: "We should dream that by 2030, Rajasthan comes in the category of number one states in the country". He said: "It can become the number one state with the way decisions are being taken by the government. We have taken excellent decisions one after the other." Hoping to form a Congress government again in the upcoming assembly elections in Rajasthan, the chief minister said: "I feel that this time (in the state) the government may repeat. It is now for the voters to decide." (PTI)

# Maharashtra CM Shinde launches cluster redevelopment programme in Thane

THANE, JUNE 6 /--/ The cluster redevelopment programme, in which several buildings in an area are rebuilt together as one unit to get economies of scale as well as space, would be extended to the entire Mumbai Metropolitan Region, said Maharashtra Chief Minister Eknath Shinde on Monday.



Launching the cluster redevelopment programme in Thane, Shinde said it was a historic move as the state government had amended rules and regulations for the relief of the people, especially those living in tenements that have been declared dangerous. "Cluster redevelopment is my dream. I remember how Sairaj building (in Shinde's locality) collapsed in 1997 and claimed several lives. As a (party) worker, I had pulled out people from the debris," said Shinde at the function, in which two couples from the ill-fated building were also invited. "The struggle (for cluster redevelopment) started then and today it is a reality. I had warned at the time that I would jump off the Assembly building if cluster redevelopment does not come through. Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis has had a lion's share in cluster redevelopment becoming reality. He could not attend due to commitments in Nagpur," he said. Various agencies like MHADA, CIDCO,

BMC etc will take over incomplete and delayed redevelopment projects in Mumbai, he said, adding that cluster redevelopment was the answer to the poor state of transit camps in the metropolis. In the first phase, a total of 10,000 tenements are being built on a cumulative area of 1,500 hectares, which will be the biggest in Asia, the CM said, adding that his dream was to create planned cities comprising cluster redevelopment projects. In the first phase two clusters measuring 7,753 square metres and 19,725 square metres will be taken up.

CIDCO MD Sanjay Mukherjee said the planning authority will be executing the project (of 10,000 homes comprising two clusters) using pre fab construction technology and for which soil testing and levelling work had begun. MLA Sanjay Kelkar hailed Shinde for the latter's role in getting the cluster redevelopment programme to take off in Thane. He urged the CM to remove SRA schemes from the cluster redevelopment programme. A few weeks ahead of the first anniversary of his government (which was formed on June 30 last year), Shinde said the state was getting all support from Prime Minister Narendra Modi. He said the previous MVA government, during its two-and-half-year tenure, had taken the state back by 10 years. (PTI)

# Arms supplier operating on behest of handlers based in USA, Dubai arrested in Delhi

NEW DELHI, JUNE 6 /--/ A 26-year-old arms supplier who was operating on the behest of handlers based in the USA and Dubai was arrested from near Sarai Kale Khan here, police said on Monday. The accused has been identified as Mukand Singh, a resident of Punjab, they said. According to police, they got a tip-off that one US-based illegal immigrant from India was supplying illegal weapons to Delhi and Punjab-based criminals affiliated with various gangs. On May 24, it was found that one of the members of the syndicate would come near the Sarai Kale Khan bus terminal to supply firearms to the members of the Lawrence Bishnoi-Kala Jathedi gang. Singh was nabbed after a trap was

laid, a senior police officer said. A total of 25 pistols, two extra magazines and 50 live cartridges were recovered from his possession. He has been supplying illicit arms and ammunition to criminals in Delhi and Punjab for the last six months, police said. Interrogation revealed that around two-year-old, Singh got acquainted with one Dilpreet Singh of Punjab.

Last year, Dilpreet migrated to the USA illegally, but both remained in touch with each other as Singh also wanted to settle abroad, the officer said. Dilpreet told him that his associate Mannu of Punjab was working as a driver in

Dubai and both of them were involved in the supply of illicit weapons to their criminal contacts in India, police said. Further, he lured Singh to join them to earn easy money. Dilpreet also offered to help him settle down in Dubai after some time. Singh agreed to work for Dilpreet, who provided him with the details of an illegal arms manufacturer based in Burhanpur in Madhya Pradesh, they said. Singh procured illegal weapons from Burhanpur and supplied them with the contact details of Dilpreet and Mannu earlier this year. It has also been revealed that Singh had once sent opium to Dilpreet through courier, police added. (PTI)

# Darknet-based drug cartel busted with 'largest ever' LSD seizure, 6 arrests: NCB

NEW DELHI, JUNE 6 /--/ The Narcotics Control Bureau on Tuesday claimed to have busted a pan-India drugs trafficking network operating on the dark web with the 'largest ever' seizure of 15,000 LSD blots in one operation and arrest of six people who are students and youngsters.

LSD or lysergic acid diethylamide is a synthetic chemical based-drug and is categorised as a hallucinogen. The network, which operated in the darknet and used cryptocurrencies for payments, was spread across Poland, the Netherlands, the US and various states in India, an official said. NCB deputy director general (northern range) Gyaneshwar Singh said that this was the "largest-ever" seizure of LSD blots in the country in a single operation. Till now, the highest seizure of LSD was 5,000 blots by the Karnataka Police in 2021 and by the Kolkata NCB in 2022 in a single operation. LSD abuse is largely prevalent among youngsters and it can lead to serious health issues, he said. (PTI)

# Pro-Khalistan slogans raised on Operation Bluestar anniversary

AMRITSAR, JUNE 6 /--/ Pro-Khalistan slogans were raised on the Golden Temple premises Tuesday by supporters and activists of radical Sikh outfits on the 39th anniversary of Operation Bluestar. The slogans of 'Khalistan Zindab' were also raised by activists of Shiromani Akali Dal (Amritsar) led by MP Simranjit Singh Mann and his associate former MP Dhian Singh Mand at the Akal Takht. Mann was also present on the spot. Radical Sikh outfit Dal Khalsa's activists were seen holding placards bearing portraits of slain militant leader Jarnail Singh Bhindrawale and raising pro-Khalistan slogans. Hundreds of Sikh youths, led by the Dal Khalsa, were carrying Khalistani flags and photographs of damaged Akal Takht. The entire marbled periphery of Golden

Temple near Akal Takht, the supreme temporal seat of Sikhs, echoed with pro-Khalistan slogans. Elaborate security arrangements were in place in Amritsar to ensure that the event passed off peacefully. Jathedar of Akal Takht Giani Harpreet Singh, in his message to the Sikh community, said the need of the hour was Sikh preachers and scholars should visit villages to promote Sikhism to apprise the youth with rich Sikh tenets and Sikh history in order to unite them under the banner of Akal Takht. Singh spoke about the issue of drug menace which has afflicted many youths. He alleged that governments would never help the Sikh community to make them strong. According to Singh, Sikhs were never scared and panicked even after the incidents that happened in 1984. "Rather all such inci-

dents had made the Sikh community stronger and Sikhs would continue their struggle to get justice and would never be scared to stand with the truth," he said. The Jathedar alleged that conspiracies were being hatched to weaken the Sikh community socially, economically and politically. Now the time has come for the community to get united, he said. He said the Sikh community did not have any positive hope from successive governments as they were attempting to take over Sikh religious institutions and also playing a major role in dividing the community by using all unfair means. On this occasion, the Shiromani Gurdwara Parbandhak Committee (SGPC), the apex Sikh religious body, displayed the bullet-ridden holy 'saroor' (volume) of the Guru Granth Sahib. (PTI)
