

Uttarakhand: 25 trekkers on mission to rediscover lost routes to Charidham

DEHRADUN, NOV 2 /-/- Tearing through deep forests, trudging up steep slopes and wading through mountain streams, a group of 25 trekkers is currently on an expedition in Uttarakhand to rediscover the lost trek routes to the Charidham.

Being carried out by the Uttarakhand Tourism Development Board in collaboration with an organisation called Trek The Himalayas, the expedition was flagged off here recently by chief minister Pushkar Singh Dhami. The trek team which consists of hikers, photographers, documentary film makers and SDRP personnel aims to find out the present condition of the routes that were used by pilgrims decades ago. The team is documenting things they come across in the course of their exploration and will submit a report to the state government on the basis of which steps will be taken to revive the routes.

Additional secretary (tourism) Yugal Kishore Pant said, "Believed to have been used by the Pandavas in the course of their passage to the Himalayas after the Mahabharata war, the ancient treks which attract pilgrims and ascetics says to reach the Himalayan temples until the 1950s fell into disuse as easier options of travelling became available to people with the build-up of motorable roads. We still see options like helicopter services to Kedarnath, Badrinath, Gangotri and Yamunotri coming available in more recent times. The treks passing through showy woods and idyllic hill villages were forgotten completely until the board...

aimed to rediscover them to give a boost to tourism and rural economy, which have been hit hard by the Covid pandemic. However, before the network of motorable roads came into being, the trek routes to the famed temples were the only option available to people. Though arduous and time taking, pilgrims trekking to the temples had a range of stopovers built every few kilometers by the Baba Kaili Kamli organisation along the way where they could rest and fight the fatigue of the long journey before resuming it. "We thought why not rediscover the trek routes and offer another option to the Charidham-bound tourists and pilgrims who had more time on their hands and willing to reach the temples through the scenic trail, halting at the chattris or monasteries on the way, passing through the hill villages and connecting with locals," Pant said.

"Reaching the temples in buses or helicopters is easy but it is an opportunity to experience things which would probably love to give an option. It is said that every pebble and stone on the trek has a story to tell," he said.

may fulfil a lifelong wish but he definitely misses out on a lot which could have been his way if he took the trek routes," the additional secretary said when asked about how the idea of rediscovering them struck him. "If the treks routes are rediscovered and made available once again they can even boost the rural economy in a big way, he said. "Pilgrims on a trek to the Charidham will look for porters, local guides, horses and mules. They may go for homestays on the way to take a breather in between the journey and opt for local cuisine. This will open up livelihood avenues for locals and boost the village economy," Pant said.

According to the official, the trek routes stood fair chances of clicking with pilgrims as there is a growing tendency post Covid among visitors to avoid going to crowded places and go instead to lesser known destinations, quiet and secluded in the hills.

YSRCP delegation meets Prez; seeks derecognition of TDP

NEW DELHI, NOV 2 /-/- A delegation of Andhra Pradesh ruling YSRCP met President Ram Nath Kovind and demanded derecognition of the TDP over the alleged use of abusive language by its leaders against chief minister YS Jagan Mohan Reddy.

YSRCP general secretary V Vijay Sai Reddy, who led the party delegation, also urged the president to direct the Union Law Ministry to formulate a law to bring the Contempt of Courts Act in Parliament that specifically penalises any deliberate and malicious acts that are intended to outrage the dignity of constitutional functionaries. YSRCP, in a representation made to the President, alleged that the Telugu Desam Party (TDP) is smearing the democratic progress in the state besides using abusive words in public domain showing the state in poor light.

Reddy said the TDP's alleged use of abusive words is gross violation of the Representation of People's Act 1951 as the Opposition party has resorted to poison the minds of people with an "orchestrated campaign by spreading false propaganda."

Stating that it is imperative to protect the sanctity of the democratic institutions...

in Andhra Pradesh from unfounded attacks by the TDP. Reddy urged the President to direct authorities concerned to take "immediate action to derecognise TDP". He said TDP leaders are using "cuss words" in public meetings, press conferences and television debates showing the state in poor light by linking it to drugs. While the chief minister is keeping his poll promise and implementing welfare schemes, the Opposition party has been "seething with intolerance and has started a smear campaign" to sow "toxic seeds in the minds of the people" more so after its rejection of people in the recent local body polls, he added.

The YSRCP leader further said even TDP chief N Chandrababu Naidu has made no attempt to condemn the remarks of his party leaders. Conspiracy to unseat UPA govt exposed: Gehloton ex-CAG Rai's apology to Nirupam for 2G charges

JAIPUR, NOV 2 /-/- Rajasthan chief minister Ashok Gehlot on Tuesday said the country today is suffering from a conspiracy to unseat the UPA government, which he said was hatched by former comptroller and auditor general of India (CAG) Vinod Rai to "tarnish" the image of the Manmohan Singh-led UPA government.

Former CAG Vinod Rai on Thursday tendered an unconditional apology to Congress leader Sanjay Nirupam for wrongly mentioning him as one of the MPs who had pressured him not to name former Prime Minister Manmohan Singh in the CAG report on 2G spectrum allocation. Nirupam had filed a defamation case against Rai after the former CAG in his book in 2014 made the allegation against him and repeated it in interviews to the media.

Accusing Rai of lowering the dignity of the constitutional post of CAG, which he held during the UPA government's rule, Gehlot said the "nation was misled over the alleged 2G spectrum allocation and coal block allocation as a result of it. The BJP came to power at the Centre which has brought a democratic uncensored critical threat."

The chief minister also called upon people to understand the "gravity of the threat to democracy and social fabric" under the BJP rule. "What Vinod Rai did was the CAG to destabilize the then UPA government is highly condemnable. He...

held a very important constitutional post which has sanctity, but Rai not only tarnished the dignity of the post but also paved the way for a fascist force to come to power at the Centre, due to which the nation is suffering badly today," Gehlot said. "Vinod Rai stands exposed, and our countrymen need to understand the conspiracy and its impact on them," the former Congress leader told PTI.

"With this, the conspiracy which was hatched to unseat the then UPA government has been exposed. As a result of the conspiracy to tarnish the image of the UPA government and mislead the people, a force which is communal and fascist came to power which has no faith in democracy. He asked whether the 2G spectrum and coal gas have gone now. Gehlot said, "Democracy flourished under the Congress rule but now it is facing a threat. We are sure that there is a need to think about it by the people."

"There is an atmosphere of fear in the country and people are suffering due to skyrocketing inflation and hike in fuel prices. Social fabric has been hit. The decision-making power of the bureaucracy has come down," the Rajasthan chief minister said.

Gehlot said that instead of presenting a vision and roadmap to revive the economy, providing employment opportunities and giving relief from unprecedented inflation and fuel prices hike, the government is selling narratives to divert public attention from the real issues which the people, particularly youths, need to understand.

He accused the Modi government of misusing CBI, ED, Income tax department and stated that the judiciary is working under pressure. Gehlot targeted the government at the Centre and the one led by Yogi Adityanath in Uttar Pradesh, accusing them of trying to divide people in the name of religion. (PTI)
