Bihar Police instructs SPs to ensure strict enforcement of SIM card registration rules

PATNA, JAN 19/-/To check misuse of SIM cards procured by cybercriminals with fake documents, Bihar Police has instructed SPs of all districts to ensure strict enforcement of mandatory SIM card registration rules by retailers and telecom communication companies, a senior officer said.

The Superintendents of Police have been asked to monitor and inspect documents used for procuring SIM cards in their respective areas on a regular basis, the officer said.

"Instruction has been issued to all SPs to ensure that guidelines of TRAI for registration of SIM cards are strictly followed by retailers and service providers. They (SPs) have been asked to monitor and inspect documents used for procuring SIM cards on a regular basis. Strict action will be initiated by police against those who are found violating TRA's guidelines", Additional Director General (ADG) of the Economic Offences Unit (EOU) of the Bihar Police, Nayyar Haseen Khan, told PTI on Thursday. The ADG said action will also be initiated against those who include in sale and purchase of pre-activated SIM cards.

"Police have asked telecom companies to book customers with SIM cards issued on fake documents and further inform the police. Investigations have revealed that criminals, liquor mafias and Naxal groups frequently obtain SIM cards with fake documents to execute crime. Besides, fraudsters also use SIM cards procured with fake documents to execute cases related to cybercrime such as money trading, sextortion, ATM fraud, debit/credit card fraud among others," he said.

Deactivating illegally procured SIM cards in bulk would lead a major blow to fraudsters, the ADG claimed. Six Bihar districts Patna, Nawada, Nalanda, Gaya, Sheikhpura and Jamui are hotspots of cybercrime in the state. There are cybercriminals based in Nawada, Gaya, Nalanda, Jamui, and Sheikhpura districts in the state working as associates for the interstate gangs operating from Rajasthan, Jharkhand, and West Bengal. Central funds for PM Awas Yojana, MGNREGA siphoned off in West Bengal: Nadda

BETHUADAHARI, JAN 19/-/BJP national president J.P. Nadda on Thursday accused the ruling TMC in West Bengal of siphoning off the money meant for MGNREGA and PM Awas Yojana, while terming allegations of the Centre stopping grants to the state as baseless.

Nadda, who is on his first visit to the state after getting another term as party president, also addressed West Bengal Chief Minister and TMC supremo Mamata Banerjee to work as per constitutional norms or face public wrath, and vowed that the saffron camp would end 'jungle raj' in the state. "Around 3.7 crore pucca houses have been built across the country under the PM Awas Yojna. But in Mamata didi's Bengal, the TMC has siphoned off the money meant for MGNREGA are being siphoned off by the ruling party. It is now blaming the Centre for stopping funds to

the state as a probe has been launched," the senior BJP leader said.

Nadda also claimed that TMC leaders are "siphoning off" the money sent by the Centre for social welfare. "Modiji sends money, and as soon as it reaches here, it is siphoned off and it turns into a scam" The TMC leaders steal money and thump their chest against the Centre," he said. Claiming that West Bengal has been brought to a "standstill" under the Trinamool Congress rule, Nadda said the BJP would end the 'jungle raj of TMC' in the state. "Modiji has said that he will not leave the corrupt and will put them in jail, and it has already started in West Bengal. The BJP will end the jungle raj in the state, we have to stop this gundaraj," he said.

Referring to the agitation against the third cut High Court against certain judgments, Nadda said, "It is shameful that the TMC is protesting against

the judiciary as some of the verdicts have not gone in their favour."

Nadda was referring to the demonstration in front of Justice Rajasekhara Mantha's courtroom in the Calcutta High Court and said that the judiciary in the country is "independent". Reacting to Nadda's comment, the TMC dubbed him a "migratory" leader with no connection with West Bengal. "Naddaji recently got an extension as party president till the 2024 Lok Sabha elections. The BJP leaders are like migratory birds in West Bengal, who come just ahead of polls and leave once defeated. Nadda offers prayers at ISKCON temple in Bengal

KRISHNANAGAR, JAN 19/-/BJP president J.P. Nadda visited the revered ISKCON temple in Mayapur in West Bengal's Nadia district on Thursday and offered prayers, as he kicked off his two-day tour of the state.

Senior party leaders, including West Bengal BJP president Sukanta Majumdar, accompanied Nadda to the global headquarters of the International Society for Krishna Consciousness. The BJP led the Krishnanagar Lok Sabha seat to the Trinamool Congress in the 2019 elections. Nadda's visit is a part of the central leadership's "Pravas" campaign to strengthen the organisation in 144 Lok Sabha constituencies across the country that the party had lost by a slender margin in the 2019 elections. Could not have attended KCR meet even if I were invited: Nitish

PATNA, JAN 19/-/Bihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar on Thursday said engagements in the state would not have allowed him to attend the meeting of opposition leaders hosted by his Telangana counterpart K Chandrasekhara Rao "even if I were invited".

The JD(U) leader, however, refused to see the Hyderabad event as a precursor to formation of an alternative Congress. BJP fronted reiterated that it would be "inational interest" if all non-NDA parties come together.

"I don't know about that meeting. I am very busy right now, I would not have been able to go even if I were invited," said the CM who

has been insisting that his hands were full with the 'Samadham Yatra' and the budget session of the assembly which will commence next month.

He, however, appeared to beoefive with that doors were still open for an alignment with the Telangana strongman who has named his Telangana Rashtra Samithi as Bharat Rashtra Samithi in what is being seen as an indication of national ambitions. "Did he not come here recently", said Kumar, referring to the visit of Rao, popularly known as KCR, to the Bihar capital shortly after the BJP was stripped of power and he has termed as 'Mahagathabandhan' formed an new government.

KCR had met Kumar as well as Nitish, the president of the RJD which he led from the seven-party ruling coalition in Bihar.

He also seemed to disagree with the notion that the meeting at Hyderabad, which was attended by leaders of the Aam Aadmi Party and the Left, was a dampener for what he has termed as a "main front" that would challenge the BJP's hegemony in the 2024 Lok Sabha polls.

"It appears to me the meeting was held as part of a party (BRS) event. Those invited there attended. This should not be seen as a new grouping", asserted Kumar. Notably, Kumar has the Congress as a junior partner of which Lalu Prasad has also been a staunch ally. There are apprehensions that KCR may be averse to the Congress which has, so far, been the principal opposition party in Telangana but faces a stiff challenge from a rapidly growing BJP. (PTI)

Special CBI court extends Anubrata Mondal's remand till Feb 3

KOLKATA, JAN 19/-/A special CBI court at Asansol on Thursday extended the judicial remand of Trinamool Congress leader Anubrata Mondal till February 3 on a prayer by the central agency, which arrested him in August last in connection with its investigation in a cattle smuggling case.

Mondal's counsel did not pray for his bail during production before the court. The CBI special court judge extended the judicial remand of the TMC Birbhum district president till February 3 on a prayer by the central probe agency. The investigating officer of the CBI informed the court of the progress in the probe, stating that several bank accounts are being probed in this connection.

The agency has already seized several accounts in Birbhum district cooperative bank's Suri branch in connection with the probe. The Calcutta High Court had on January 4 rejected the bail prayer of Mondal, observing that he continues to hold a powerful political post and has overwhelming influence not only in society but upon the state administration. The CBI has claimed that the TMC leader illegally aided and abetted alleged cattle smuggler Enamul Haque and used his influence to ensure smooth passage of cattle through Birbhum and Murshidabad districts to reach the international border in lieu of wrongful gains.
